



From the start in 1988, PONANT's founders stood out for their innovative approach with a new French flag, then the launch of an exceptional sailing yacht followed by four small capacity ships with character, Le Boréal, L'Austral, Le Soléal and Le Lyrial. A new series of six sistership expedition yachts, the PONANT EXPLORERS, will join the fleet between 2018 and 2020, then 2021 will see the arrival of the first cruise icebreaker, Le Ponant Icebreaker.

#### THE SAILBOAT

#### Le Ponant

This superb three mast sailing yacht has just 32 cabins, all decorated in a harmonious palette of maritime shades. As on a private yacht, there is a select group of guests on board, people who truly love the sea and sailing under wind power.

#### THE FOUR SISTERSHIPS

#### Le Boréal, L'Austral, Le Soléal and Le Lyrial

These four sisterships, elegant yachts with 122 to 132 cabins and suites, perpetuate our philosophy: limited capacity, unique atmosphere, a subtle combination of luxury, privacy and well-being. Quality materials, discreet refinement, and a natural blend of relaxed elegance, our ships give your customers the chance to enjoy the unique experience of feeling as though they were aboard their own yacht.

Designed specifically for the Polar destinations, the sisterships obtained Comfort Class 1, the highest marks awarded by Bureau Veritas.

#### THE PONANT EXPLORERS

Le Lapérouse and Le Champlain (delivered in 2018), Le Bougainville and Le Dumont-d'Urville (delivered in 2019), Le Bellot and Le Surville (delivered in 2020).

A new generation of ships flying under the French flag, fitted with the latest technologies, certified as a 1C class (the ice class), the PONANT EXPLORERS comply with the most recent environmental regulations and have been awarded the "Cleanship" label (Bureau Veritas).

Just 88 cabins, each with a private balcony, 4 suites, each with a plate glass window and private terrace... The limited-capacity PONANT EXPLORERS are designed for landing in the most inaccessible locations, where others do not go.

#### LE COMMANDANT CHARCOT

The first hybrid electric polar exploration vessel powered by Liquefied Natural Gas, *Le Commandant Charcot* is a pioneer in terms of environmental protection. With just 135 staterooms and luxury service, this innovative polar vessel is "Cleanship" certified. The ship will take passengers to rarely explored polar destinations, such as the geographic North Pole (90 degrees North Latitude), the Weddell Sea, the Ross Sea and Peter I Island.







The company's first ship, small scale with shallow draft and a design very open to the sea, this threemasted flagship of our fleet gives passengers the feeling they are on a private yacht.

# AN INTIMATE FRIENDLY ATMOSPHERE OPEN TO THE SEA

Enjoying a meal outdoors, diving into the sea from the marina, or watching the sails being unfurled from the large 400 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck, for passengers *Le Ponant* is about life in the open air.

The 32 staterooms all have a porthole. Two comfortable lounges and two restaurants complete the intimate spaces on this beautiful sailing yacht.

Nautical elements, sophistication and comfort: from a palette of azure blues to grey-blue, this yacht evokes the spirit of yachting (latest renovation in 2014).

32 staterooms all offering a magnificent panoramic view of the sea.

# THE PONANT EXPLORERS



PONANT is expanding its unique luxury expedition cruise concept with the arrival of six new sisterships, the PONANT EXPLORERS.

Le Lapérouse and Le Champlain are joining the fleet in 2018, followed by Le Bougainville and Le Dumont-d'Urville in 2019 then Le Bellot and Le Surville in 2020.

#### A DIFFERENT KIND OF EXPEDITION

Fitted with innovative equipment, elegantly designed cabins, spacious suites with windows, and lounge areas opening onto the outside, these six new limited-capacity yachts (131 metres long with 92 cabins and suites) provide a unique cruising experience thanks to their design and their small size. The PONANT EXPLORERS are fitted with a movable marina platform, enabling passengers to swim and engage in other activities directly from the ship.

# BLUE EYE, THE FIRST MULTI-SENSORY UNDERWATER LOUNGE WORLDWIDE

The six yachts are fitted with a world exclusive multi-sensory underwater lounge, called Blue Eye. Located within the hull beneath the water line, it allows passengers to see, hear and feel the underwater world. This exclusive concept, a veritable technological achievement, has been designed in collaboration with the architect Jacques ROUGERIE.

#### THE ULTIMATE EXPLORATION

Reach the true Geographic North Pole at 90 degrees latitude North, step foot on the ice, cross the Arctic Ocean, discover the far north-east of Greenland, the Weddell Sea, the Ross Sea, reach Peter I Island. PONANT is taking its passengers in the footsteps of the great polar explorers, aboard the very first new-generation polar exploration vessel ever designed.

This new polar Odyssey, promises to be a magnificent adventure in a in a luxurious setting, with services never before available on this type of ship, which has been specially designed for extreme destinations: on-board Zodiacs, large panoramic suites, Duplex suites with private terrace and spa, personalized service, heated outdoor swimming pool and a giant fire pit, indoor pool extended by a winter garden, gastronomic cuisine, spa, and more.

# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AT THE HEART OF THE DESIGN

Flying the French flag, this ship equipped with ice-breaker capacity, will be fitted with the latest environmental protection technology and will have a hybrid liquefied natural gas (LNG) and electric propulsion system. This will allow a reduction in the ship's emissions of SO2, NOx, CO2 and fine particulate matter. There will be silent sailing in sensitive areas: thanks to electric batteries, the ship will be able to sail for 30 minutes without producing any emissions and with a very low noise level. It will be equipped with the latest technology to optimise energy consumption, wastewater treatment and waste processing.

Le Commandant Charcot will also contain a modern laboratory.







Ashore as at sea, PONANT applies strict safety regulations that are subject to regular international controls.



#### FRENCH FLAG

Top of the Paris MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) ranking for flags in 2013 and 2014, the French flag is deemed to be the safest in the world. PONANT is the only cruise ship operator flying this flag, a guarantee of environmental quality, ship safety and staff working conditions.

The fleet is monitored by the PACA Corsica CSN (Centre de Sécurité des Navires) in Marseille. All safety equipment is checked and certified every year by the French administration and Bureau Veritas.

Each ship has the ISM (International Safety Management) certification, a very strict international regulation.

On board, each passenger has their own lifejacket in the cabin and near to the lifeboats. The ship evacuation drill, involving all the passengers, is organized before the departure of every cruise. The ships are also equipped with other detection devices, including fire extinguishing systems, and fireproof and watertight doors.

#### POLAR REGIONS SPECIALIST

The position of the PONANT fleet is monitored in real time, even in the polar regions. The captain is assisted by an officer specialised in sailing in icy waters and the crew is trained in the behaviour required for navigation in the region and for survival in polar waters. With their reinforced hulls and a structure certified by Bureau Veritas, the sisterships were awarded "Ice IC" classification, authorising them to sail in the polar regions. The safety equipment aboard allows the ships to withstand extreme conditions while waiting for help to arrive in the event of a problem.

Le Commandant Charcot, the first polar exploration vessel, will be built to the standards of Polar Class 2. A world first which will give this ship the capacities of a high-performance icebreaker, capable of sailing in all types of ice, even the most extreme, whilst guaranteeing the highest levels of safety for our guests. Optimal manoeuvrability, autonomy and comfort are guaranteed in all circumstances, there will be a permanent power supply thanks to the hybrid-electric engines and the safety equipment has been specifically designed for the company. This ship is designed to withstand any situation in the extreme polar regions, going beyond what is required by the regulations.

#### OFFICERS TRAINING

In 2013, PONANT and the ENSM (Ecole Nationale Supérieure Maritime) naval academy in Marseille inaugurated an ice navigation simulator, the only one in France, developed using data provided by the company's ships and officers who are experienced in this type of navigation. The device is used to train young officers in the organisation of the Bridge, and how to navigate in polar environments, amidst the drifting ice and in extreme weather conditions (snow storms, heavy seas, etc.).

#### AN ONGOING COMMITMENT

From  $1^{\rm st}$  January 2019, PONANT decided to definitively stop using HFO and replace it with Low Sulphur Marine Gasoil, LS MGO. This fuel considerably reduces Sulphur and fine particulate matter emissions.

Given that its ships are cruising in sensitive areas, PONANT has an ongoing commitment to improve its performance in terms of protecting the environment by:

- Obtaining the "CLEANSHIP" certification for each new ship.
- Fully complying with environmental regulations for its operations and anticipating new regulations.
- Developing and implementing techniques, procedures and partnerships that combine performance and preservation of the environment and communities visited on cruises.

#### RESPONSIBLE CRUISE

From the design stage of its ships to landings, everything is done to reduce the company's impact on the environment: carefully selected itineraries, cruising under sail on *Le Ponant*, raising awareness among passengers and crew for responsible behaviour.

- Our commitment goes beyond environmental aspects. We are also clear about our responsibility towards local populations. Our commitment goes beyond environmental aspects. We are also clear about our responsibility towards local populations. We take care to consult them over important decisions and we involve them in the activities on offer during ports of call. We have even been known to provide them with medical support. In this way, we have developed strong partnership with local communities in Greenland, Argentina and also in France.
- We develop each of our expedition cruises in close collaboration with the natives. We work with specialized Ethnologists to build with them the tourist practices of which they are the protagonists. They are the ones who decide what they want to share in their cultures and their environment. Thus involved, the local populations are no longer considered passive actors of tourism.
- We have even been known to provide them with medical support. In this way, we have developed strong partnership with local communities in Greenland, Argentina and also in France.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

- · Waste is sorted aboard ships in accordance with MARPOL regulations for the prevention of marine pollution. PONANT works to optimise the management of its waste when on land. Our aim is to add value to all our packaging. We have put in place a working group dedicated to this subject that includes representatives from all the company's departments.
- · Sanitary and waste water are regularly checked to ensure their compliance. Waste water treatment residues are offloaded in ports and given to specialised companies for the appropriate treatment. Ponant has placed a high priority on eliminating plastics in the oceans through a "life cycle" approach that includes source reduction, manufacturing, transportation, use and end of life. We pay attention to the elimination of non-recyclable plastic products.
- Fuel consumption is monitored aboard ships and at the head office. A calculation of our greenhouse gas emissions is made each year.

#### CUTTING-EDGE TECHNOLOGIES

- · Water treatment: Our ships are equipped with a complete desalinisation system and a wastewater treatment system: a submerged membrane bioreactor. This biodegrading process - free from the use of chemical products - is very reliable. It produces clean water and meets the highest standards of quality. This system is certified according to IMO 2017 regulations and has a GREEN PASSPORT which affirms its respect for the environment. The quality of the water obtained means it does not need chlorination or any other chemical treatment. The pureness of the water produced means it can be used aboard the ship, notably in the laundries.
- Waste processing: we have compactors that are adapted to each type of waste. This allows us to optimise storage volumes and disembarkation operations at ports.
- · Navigation aids: PONANT is working on an innovative project using digital navigation. Our ships will be fitted with an electronic assistance system that will ensure optimal fuel consumption.

# A UNIQUE TALE OF SAILORS



- LA COMPAGNIE DES ÎLES DU PONANT launches in Nantes on April 1, founded by 14 sailors aged 23 to 29: Jean Emmanuel SAUVÉE, Philippe VIDEAU and a dozen other young officers who had only recently graduated from the Merchant Navy academy. To realise their dream, they come up with an innovative solution for operating ships, which includes a new French flag. They also rely on an unusual means of funding by launching a public offering in 1989 to build their first ship.
- 1991 *Le Ponant*, the first of the fleet and the company's legendary sailing yacht, is built at the Villeneuve-La-Garenne shipyard in France.
- The company joins CMA CGM, moves to Marseille and becomes LA COMPAGNIE DU PONANT. In 2007, at the instigation of the Group, heir to the Compagnie des Messageries Maritimes and Compagnie Générale Transatlantique, the company embarks on a bold new adventure: to design the ideal cruise ship which results in the launch of four sisterships, built by the Italian Fincantieri shipyard, starting with *Le Boréal* launched in 2010, followed by *L'Austral* in 2011.
- The acquisition of LA COMPAGNIE DU PONANT from the CMA CGM Group by investment firm Bridgepoint provides the means to continue its growth and take the company onto the next stage of its development into other international markets. A third sistership, *Le Soléal*, is launched in 2013. In keeping with the company's pioneering spirit, she becomes the first French commercial ship to cross the Northwest Passage, from Greenland to Siberia with 200 passengers on board in September 2013.
- 2014 LA COMPAGNIE DU PONANT becomes PONANT, an eponymous brand bearing the name of the first ship and founding element of the brand. This name change comes at an important stage in the company's history to support its development in France and abroad.

# A STORY LIKE NO OTHER

- The launch of *Le Lyrial* in April 2015 marks the last of this superb series of four latest generation sisterships, unique in the cruise sector due to their size and innovative design. The acquisition of PONANT by Artémis, holding company of the Pinault family, allows PONANT to pursue its maritime adventure, building a promising future, based on its savoir-faire, its original ideas and an enormous amount of hard work from all the crews and onshore teams.
- 2016 PONANT announces order of the PONANT EXPLORERS series: four exceptional yachts, specially designed for expeditions. The first two will arrive for the Summer 2018 season and the other two in 2019.
- 2017 PONANT announced the order for the first hybrid electric polar exploration vessel powered by Liquefied Natural Gas, *Le Commandant Charcot*.
- 2018 PONANT announces an order for two additional ships for the PONANT EXPLORERS series, *Le Bellot* and *Le Surville*, delivery of which is scheduled for 2020.





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
