On December 4, 2021, an event will forever mark your life as a traveler-explorer.

How will it happen? Aboard *Le Commandant-Charcot*, the upcoming high-polar exploration vessel from PONANT.

Some opportunities in life only come along once. The polar expedition planned by the PONANT experts will allow you to experience a unique moment untouched by time: witnessing the solar eclipse on December 4, 2021 in the only area in the world where it will be fully visible, the edge of Antarctica.

Initiatory journey to the heart of the Weddell sea ice floes

From Ushuaia, *Le Commandant-Charcot*, a latest-generation PC2 polar class vessel, eco-designed with the latest green technologies - hybrid electric, propelled by Liquefied Natural Gas, 100% of waste sorted on board, wastewater treatment - will set sail for the Weddell sea ice pack, in the heart of the White Continent.

In this region, where the sun never quite sets, a dark night will envelop the ship during the eclipse and allow you to fully experience this fascinating time.

"We will be positioned in the heart of the sea ice, where the pristine white creates a high-pressure zone that will allow for clearer skies. Guests will have the privilege of witnessing this rare phenomenon from the ice pack", says Nicolas Dubreuil, Polar and Tropical Expedition Expert and Director of Sustainability at PONANT.

Experts and scientists on board will study this exceptional natural phenomenon and will involve passengers in their analyses. It will also be an opportunity for them to carry out sampling and analysis in these remote areas.

"This journey is one of a kind in a lifetime, full of meaning for future guests who will realise how important it is to preserve this incredible place", concludes Nicolas Dubreuil.
