They will have the possibility to cancel without charge up and for whatever reason up to 30 days before departure by benefiting from a cruise credit for 100% of the sums paid on a new reservation within 24 months of the initial departure.

In addition, thanks to the Covid guarantee included, passengers benefit from optimum protection. In the event of a positive Covid test within 30 days prior to departure, guests are offered a free postponement or cancellation. All payments will be fully refunded, even if the cruise cannot be operated.
