Pearls of the Society Islands – NEW

Departing from Papeete, this exceptional voyage sets out to discover the wealth of nature's treasures and thousand-year-old Polynesian traditions of the Society Islands. The *m/s Paul Gauguin* will sail to the mysterious Huahine, a garden of Eden with isolated coves. Cradle of Polynesian culture, Raiatea will unveil its many treasures, from Nature at her most enchanting and historic marvels. Next will come the *motu* Mahana, a sparkling gem in the Taha'a lagoon teeming with colourful fish, Bora Bora, and finally Moorea. An intriguing escape from the everyday awaits to experience bewitching scenery and a rich marine diversity.

Marquesas in depth, Tuamotus and Society Islands – NEW

This will be an opportunity to explore the wonders of the seabed around the Fakarava atoll, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, and dive into the history and culture of Polynesia, particularly the ancestral craftsmanship. The beautiful islands of the Marquesas follow, Hiva Oa, Tahuata, Nuka Hiva, Ua Pou, then Bora Bora, *motu* Mahana and Tahiti.

Tahiti & the Society Islands

This unforgettable voyage reveals the secrets of the Society Islands and why their beauty has inspired so many artists like Henri Matisse, Paul Gauguin and Jacques Brel. From Papeete, the ship sets sail for Huahine's secluded coves, the turquoise blue waters of *motu* Mahana, Bora Bora's legendary lagoons and Moorea's lush vegetation. An itinerary that explores the must-sees of French Polynesia, be it emerald lagoons, white sandy beaches, deserted creeks, tropical forests or lush green native gardens.

From lush green tropical forests on the Society Islands to palm fringed lagoons as far as the eye can see, this voyage into the heart of French Polynesia reveals all the charms of Bora Bora, Moorea and of the *motu* Mahana, before heading into the Tuamotos archipelago to discover the breathtaking Rangiroa island, famous for its black pearl culture. In the idyllic setting of the Fakarava atoll, snorkelling in the natural aquarium of coral reefs teeming with colourful fish, rays and harmless sharks is a must.
